OPENER:

Circle left. Well, it's a marvelous night for a moondance with the stars up above in your eyes. **Left allemande**, **dosado**, now **left allemande** and **weave the ring.** And all the leaves on the trees are fallin' to the sound of the breezes that blow. **And I'm tryin' to please to the callin' of your heartstrings that play soft and low.

FIGURE (Twice for heads, twice for sides):

The **heads (sides) square thru** get me four now, 'round the corner do a **dosado**. You better **swing thru** tonight. The **boys run** right, **chain down the line** you know. **Pass thru, partner trade, and roll** to face 'em. **Swing** your corner, all **promenade.** A fantabulous night to make romance 'neath the cover of October skies.

MIDDLE BREAK:

Circle left. And all the night's magic seems to whisper and hush. You do a **left allemande, dosado** now, **left allemande** and you **weave.** Can I just have one more moondance with you, my love? Can I just make some more romance with you, my love?

CLOSER:

Four boys promenade. Get back home and you **swing.** Join hands **circle left** now, **left allemande** and **weave the ring.** Can I just have one more moondance with you, my love? Can I just make some more romance with you...

TAG:

Sides face **grand square.** One more moondance... In the moonlight... On a magic night... La la la la... *(Music fades)*

ALTERNATE LYRICS:

**There and then all my dreams will come true, dear; There and then I will make you my own.
