## **Opener, Middle Break & Closer:**

**(Sides face Grand Square)** In the morning you go gunnin' for the man who stole your water. And you fire 'til he is done in but they catch you at the border. **(Circle Left)** You go back, Jack, do it again. **Left allemande, swing and promenade.** Go back, Jack, do it again.

## **Figures (Twice for heads, twice for sides):**

**Heads (Sides) lead right, you veer left, girls hinge, flip the diamond.** Do an **Acey Deucey, boys run right. Girls trade, ferris wheel. Centers square thru, three hands** you know, **swing** your corner, all **promenade.** You go back, Jack, do it again.

## **No Tag**

### ***Use these lyrics during the Opener:***

In the morning you go gunnin' for the man who stole your water. And you fire 'til he is done in but they catch you at the border. You go back, Jack, do it again. Wheel turnin' 'round and 'round, you go back, Jack, do it again.

### ***Use these lyrics during the Middle Break:***
