Opener:

Sides face **grand square**. There's a silence here between us I've never heard before. (And) I can't find the love in her eyes anymore. (**Allemande** and **weave**) There's some changes goin' on I'm beginnin' to understand. When I'm holdin' her I swear I feel the presence of another man.

Figures (Twice for the heads, twice for the sides):

Heads (Sides) **Square thru** and go four hands, **dosado** your girl. **Swing thru** and then, **recycle** friend, **veer to the left**, **boys hinge**. **Cut the diamond**, then **ferris wheel**, **centers pass thru**, **swing** and **promenade**. There's a stranger in my house. Somebody here tryin' to take her away from me.

Middle Break:

Sides face **grand square**. She sits starin' out the window a million miles away. (And) when I ask if she's all right she never has too much to say. (**Allemande** and **weave**) Is it somebody we both know? Or somebody she just met? Is she lovin' him in her mind while she's lyin' here in my bed?

Closer:

Sides face **grand square**. Suspicions lead to questions and questions to alibis. Is it just my imagination? Or has her love turned into lies? (**Allemande** and **weave**) There's a stranger in my house. Somebody here that I can't see. A stranger in my house. Somebody here tryin' to take her away from me.
